This is especially clear in the membership of the Pastor Nominating Committee and participation in the Sunday ministries of the church (think lectors and children's ministry providers). As my beloved husband used to say in his Navy days, "Bravo Zulu!"

The energy you all exhibit during worship is palpable, particularly since the move to a single 10:00 service. I do understand that the move hasn't been easy for many of you and I am grateful that you have made a sacrifice in order to worship at 10:00. The congregation of Parkway is best when it is together in all manner of ways.

If I could have my "druthers," I'd druther more of you would make use of the church's excellent website, parkwaypres.com. There you will find our calendar, which is updated as soon as new events or activities are known. The newsletters are posted and archived there. A church's web page is often called the new front door of the church; going through that door will reveal a pretty awesome congregation.

Finally, to paraphrase Mark Twain, news of my departure has been greatly exaggerated. I appreciate, deeply, your kind expressions of farewell. I'm here for three more months and we still have plenty to do!

Nine months ago, I told you all this and I still mean it...

"And from this moment, be reminded of who and what you already are. By the Father's will, Christ's way and the Spirit's guidance, we will all grow in love for God and one another. Be mindful. You are people of God's community, as you have shown through your love for this congregation.
